Construction Activities: The most exciting activity has been the start of the heavy timber system on the second level deck. The system components arrived from British Columbia, and are being installed. The form of the main library space can now be easily seen from offsite. Other activities include the drilling and pouring of footings for the Community Hall and the forming and pouring of the Staff Wing foundation.

Library Public Art: Oakland Museum staff facilitated two panels to review the qualifications of over 100 public artists for the Outdoor Corridor and Children's Activity Deck commissions.
