**Construction Activities:** On the exterior, the sheeting and trellis and canopy structures are being installed. The walls of the Community Hall and Staff Wing are being constructed. There is more utility work. On the interior, walls are continuing to be constructed and insulation installed. Utility work continues.

**Construction Funding:** To date, the State has reimbursed the City \$9,875,122 in grant funds for construction costs. Earlier this year, the City and Redevelopment Agency entered into agreements with the Lafayette Library and Learning Center Foundation – Loan, Funding, Use, and Logo License. The Loan Agreement stipulates that the Foundation will loan the Agency \$9,000,000 for project construction. Finally, the Agency has begun the process to issue redevelopment bonds to fund the remaining project construction costs.
